

Supplemental Fig. 2. Bispectral index (BIS, a) and electromyographic activity (EMG, b) at different times in deep and non-deep sedation assessments.

Data are shown as mean + or - SD. Deep sedation was defined as a Richmond Agitation Scale (RASS) level of - 3 to - 5. Other RASS levels indicated non-deep sedation. BIS and EMG values in the deep sedation assessment were significantly lower than those in the non-deep sedation assessment (P < 0.001), and in both datasets, values after stimulation were significantly higher than those before stimulation (P < 0.001).
