

Does your residency program training (or part of its training) occur at a Level 1 Trauma Center?



Does your residency program have a formal rotation in trauma anesthesiology?



What level residents participate in the trauma rotation? (select all that apply)



Do you see the benefit of such rotation for your resident's education?







Do you believe your residents have sufficient exposure to emergency surgery for life-threatening or multi-organ trauma?


