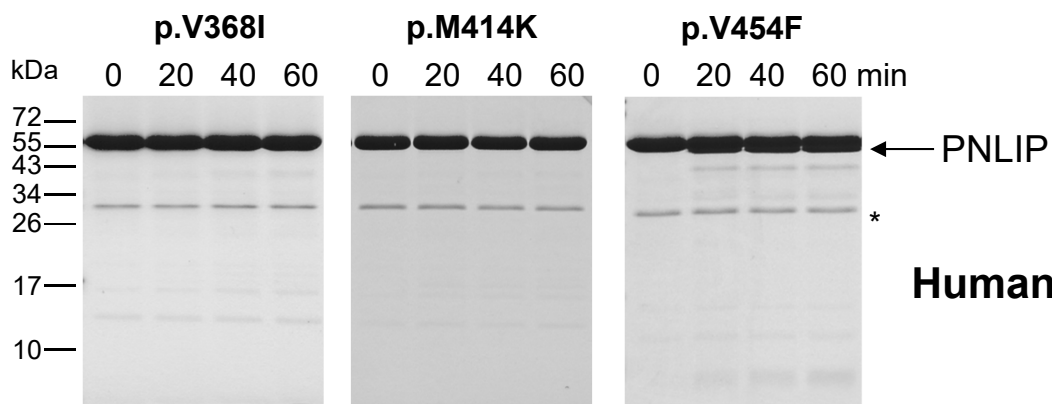
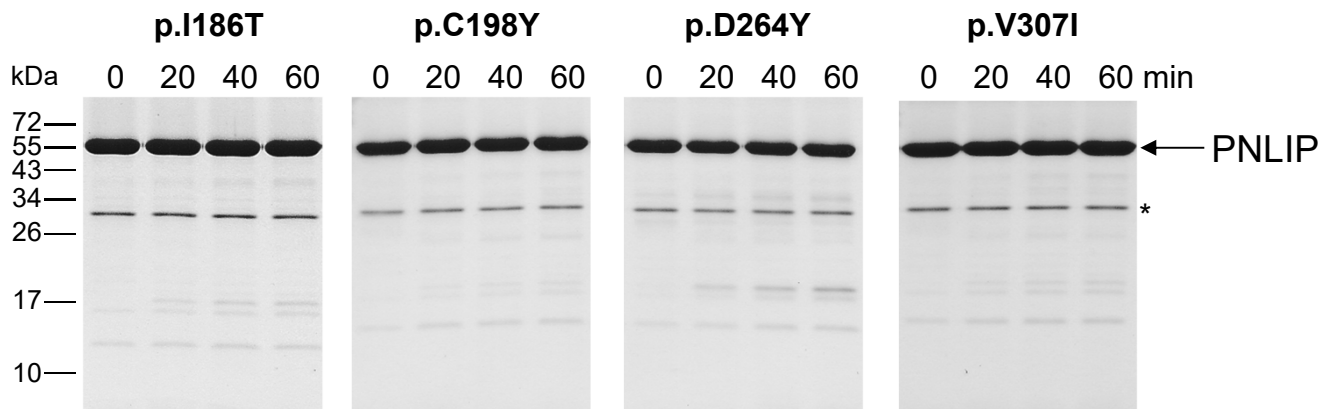
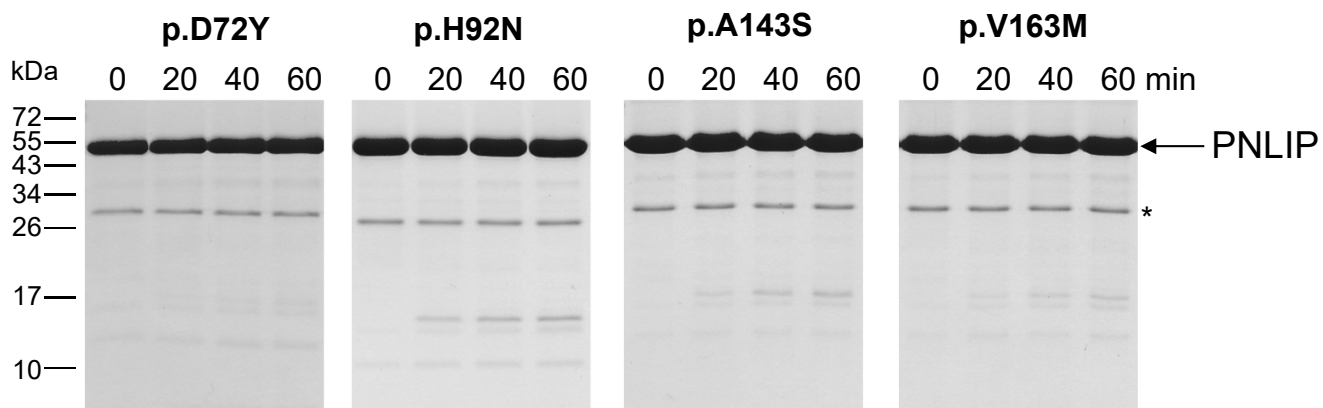
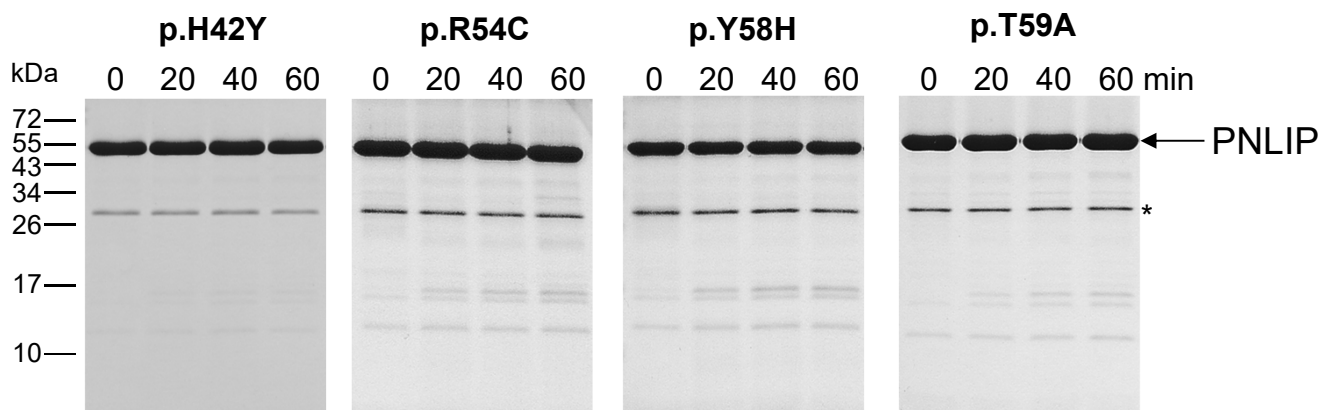


**Supplementary Figure 1.** The effect of human cationic trypsin (PRSS1) on human pancreatic lipase (PNLIP) variants. Digestion experiments were carried out as detailed in *Methods*. The figure demonstrates representative gels from two experiments for all PNLIP variants where no significant degradation by PRSS1 was observed. The PRSS1-sensitive PNLIP variants are shown in Figure 3. The asterisk indicates the PRSS1 band. Note that the PNLIP band of mutant p.V454F is a doublet as trypsin cleaves this mutant close to the C terminus, in all likelihood after Arg455.
