

Head motion statistics at 0% and 1.2% sevoflurane. The plotted quantity is the DVARS measure (temporal derivative of RMS BOLD signal across voxels)¹ averaged over retained frames contributing to functional connectivity (FC) analyses in each subject. DVARS captures changes in fMRI BOLD signal intensity associated with motion artifact. Frames of data surpassing a DVARS threshold were excluded from analysis. The DVARS distributions means for remaining frames are not different (p = 0.62, two-tailed t-test).
