

Supplementary Figure S4- Effects of misplaced (out sites) injections of the drugs in mechanical and thermal sensitivity evaluated by the von Frey (panels A, C, E, G, I) and hot plate (panels B, D, F, H, J) tests, respectively. The drugs were microinjected 7 days after minipumps implantation, and their effects were assessed before and after the injection. The interactions between groups and time or treatments and time are presented at the bottom of the x-axis. Lidocaine increased withdrawal thresholds but did not fully reverse mechanical hypersensitivity (panel A). No significant effects were found for lidocaine in the hot plate test ($F_{1,4} = 0.7$, $P_{1,4} = 0.7$, $P_{1,5} = 0.7$, $P_{1,5$
