

Obtaining Sterile Equipment

- **Collect sterile parts:** 1. Drill cover 2. Drill shaft

Sterile

3. Chuck key





Preparing Sterile Drill Cover

2.1. Roll drill cover edge back 2 times. Expose only inside lining of drill cover to non-sterile team member



2.2. Make sure sterile team member's gloves are tucked under fabric (\rightarrow) and away from opening of the drill cover

4.1. Sterile nurse presents the rolled up cover



5.1. Unfold drill cover and tightly roll drill cover opening 3 times




Sealing The Drill Cover



Set torque to MAX





6.1. Pull back loose fabric, expose receiving end drill chuck. DO NOT push unsterile drill through opening (\rightarrow)



6.2. Insert shaft into drill. You should feel a click. DO NOT remove shaft once inserted





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Transfering The Drill

4.2. Non-sterile nurse inserts drill into cover Drill and nonsterile hand can only touch the inside fabric of the cover







5.2. Buckle clip



6.3. Screw together chuck and drill cover untill tight and red O-ring is no longer visible

Insert drill bit and tighten with chuck key
