CCC MOBILE APP: Nursing Plan of Care Pathway Example

<u>Initial Screen</u>: (Home: Returns to Initial Screen)

CCC Lookup Tool: (Care Component / Assessment):

Welcome to the CCC Mobile Lookup App designed specifically for the Clinical Care Classification (CCC) System. It is designed to be used on your MOBILE/SMART PHONE to assist the nurse/clinician with the documentation of a nursing plan of care (PoC). It will lead you through the CCC System's six steps of the nursing process:(Assessment, Diagnosis, Goal /Expected Outcome, Nursing Intervention & Action Type, and Actual Outcome), and serves as a guide for selecting: S1) Care Component, S2) Diagnosis, S3) Goal, S4) Intervention with S5) Action Type and on discharge S^) Actual Outcome. It concludes with a Summary Plan of your selections.

Example Text: Please start by <u>selecting a Care Component</u> based on Signs/Symptoms of

patient's condition

Step 2/ Screen: Diagnosis for Care Component: Respiratory (L):

Lists the <u>Diagnoses/ Problems</u> specific for the selected Care Component which is based on the specific Assessed Sign & Symptom. The nurse/clinician has to select the most appropriate Diagnosis/Problem for the focus of the Nursing Plan of Care.

Example: Respiratory Care Component (L): Definition

Select a Diagnosis - to see definition/code & Goals

Selected: Respiratory Alteration: L26.0

Step 3/ Screen: Goals (Expected Outcome) for Diagnosis: Respiratory Alteration:

Lists the <u>Goal's</u> three options: (Improve, Stabilize, Support Deterioration) of which, nurse/clinician has to select one to reflect the Planning process for the PoC. The three Goals are presented in future tense depicting the proposed results of the nursing intervention/action.

Example: Respiratory Alteration: L26.0: Definition

Select one Goal-to see the intervention:

- 1) To Improve Respiratory Alteration: L26.0.1
- 2) To Stabilize Respiratory Alteration: L26.0.2
- 3) To (Support) Deterioration of Respiratory Alteration:L26.0.3

Step 4/ Screen: Interventions for Care Component: Respiratory (L):

Lists the Nursing <u>Interventions</u> specific for the selected Care Component which is based on the Assessed Sign & Symptom for the PoC and for which the nurse/clinician has to select one to move on to the Action Type screen.

Example: Respiratory Care Component (L): Definition

Select an **Intervention** - to see definition/code & Action Types

Oxygen Therapy Care: L35.0

Step 5/ Screen: Intervention & Action Types for: Oxygen Therapy Care:

Lists the Intervention's four <u>Action Types</u> options: (Assess/ Monitor, Perform/ Provide Care, Teach/ Instruct, or Manage/ Refer), one of which the nurse/clinician MUST select to depict the actual implementation process. Each of the four Action Types enhances the Nursing Intervention and gives it depth making it possible to measure time and cost, determine workflow, and quality outcomes.

Example: Oxygen Therapy Care - Definition

Select one Action Type:

- 1) Assess or Monitor-Oxygen Therapy Care: L35.0.1
- 2) Perform or Provide Care-Oxygen Therapy Care:L35.0.2
- 3) Teach or Instruct-Oxygen Therapy Care: L35.0.3
- 4) Manage or Refer-Oxygen Therapy Care: L35.0.4

Step 6/ Screen: Actual Outcomes for Diagnosis: Respitatory Alteration:

Lists the <u>Actual Outcome's</u> three options: (Improved, Stabilized, Deteriorated) of which the nurse/clinician has to select one that reflects the Outcome Evaluation process for the PoC. The three Goals are presented in past tense depicting the achieved result of the one Nursing Diagnosis/ Problem.

Example: Select Actual Outcome-when completed or on Discharge-to see the Summary Plan

- 1) Improved Respiratory Alteration: L26.0.1
- 2) Stabilized Respiratory Alteration L26.0.2
- 3) Deteriorated Respiratory Alteration: L26.0.3

Summary Plan/ Screen: (PoC Pathway)

The last screen is a summary of the nurse/clinician selections for each of the six screens of the CCC System Plan of Care which follows the six steps of the Nursing Process and which itemizes one Care Pathway. The Summary Plan can be copied (recommended) onto the patient's desktop Plan of Care. This Care Pathway is generally combined with other Care Pathways for the other patient Diagnoses/ Problems and Nursing Interventions/ Action Types needed to build a comprehensive electronic Nursing PoC for the patient's disease conditions.

Example:

S1: Selected **Care Component**: Respiratory Care Component (L)

S2/S3: Selected **Diagnosis** & **Goal**: To Improve Respiratory Alteration (L26.0.1)

S4/S5: Selected **Intervention** & **Action Type**: Perform Oxygen Therapy Care: (L35.0.2)

S6: Selected Actual **Outcome** of Diagnosis: Stabilized Respiratory Alteration (L26.0.**2**)

<u>Home</u>: Returns to Original Screen.
