- 1) Prior medical experience:
 - a. Did anyone have a prior job in neurology prior to your current job? What was it like?
- 2) Onboarding experience:
 - a. Describe your onboarding and training experience when you started your current job?
 - b. When you started, did you receive too much or too little supervision?
 - c. Any suggestions about how this could be improved?
- 3) Resources:
 - a. What resources (online, text, colleagues, for example) did you find most useful when you were first growing accustomed to your current job?
 - b. Do you find these existing resources appropriate and accessible for an APP?
 - c. What opportunities exist for you in continuing medical education that are specifically tailored to APPs and focus on neurology?
 - d. What resources would like to have? What resources do you feel are missing?
- 4) Clinical situations
 - a. What clinical diagnoses were you most comfortable with when starting? Most uncomfortable?
 - b. What components of your job were most difficult when starting?
 - i. For example, performing the neurologic exam, reviewing imaging on rounds or for clinic patients, interpreting various results, communication with other providers, communication with patients, discussion with family, procedures
 - c. What could have been done to make these difficult diagnoses easier to handle or these difficult tasks easier to get used to?
- 5) Neurology content
 - a. Which areas of neurology do you wish you had more familiarity with?
- 6) Communication
 - a. Tell us about your experiences communicating with physicians and other providers:
 - i. In the hospital (inpatient)?
 - ii. In the outpatient setting (clinic)?
 - b. Have you ever felt that physicians talking on rounds or talking directly with you were speaking at a level you did not comprehend?
 - i. If so, what specifically was difficult?
 - ii. Have you ever experienced disrespectful communication?
 - c. What do neurologists in this department assume APPs were taught during their training that they actually are not?
 - d. Do you feel you have had any challenges in communicating with other providers (outside the department)?
 - i. If so, why? Give specific examples.
 - e. How might communication between APPs, physicians, and others in our department be improved?
