

[§]Exercise Participation Performing planned, structured physical activity at least 30 min at moderate intensity on at least 3 days per

week for at least the last 3 months.

*Light Intensity Exercise: 30-<40% HRR or VO2R, 2-<3 METS, RPE 9-11, an intensity that causes slight increases in HR and breathing

** Moderate Intensity 40-<60% HRR or VO2R, 3-<6 METS, RPE 12-13, an intensity that causes noticeable increases in HR and

Exercise breathing

***Vigorous Intensity 60-<90% HRR or VO2R, 6-<8.8METS, RPE 14-17, an intensity that causes substantial increases in HR and

Exercise breathing

[‡] Cardiovascular (CV) Cardiac, peripheral vascular, or cerebrovascular disease.

Disease

***Metabolic Disease Type 1 and 2 diabetes mellitus.

****Signs and Symptoms At rest or during activity. Includes pain, discomfort in the chest, neck, jaw, arms, or other areas that may result

from ischemia; shortness of breath at rest or with mild exertion; dizziness or syncope; orthopnea or

paroxysmal nocturnal dyspnea; ankle edema; palpitations or tachycardia; intermittent claudication; known

heart murmur; unusual fatigue or shortness of breath with usual activities.

*****Medical Clearance Approval from a healthcare professional to engage in exercise.
