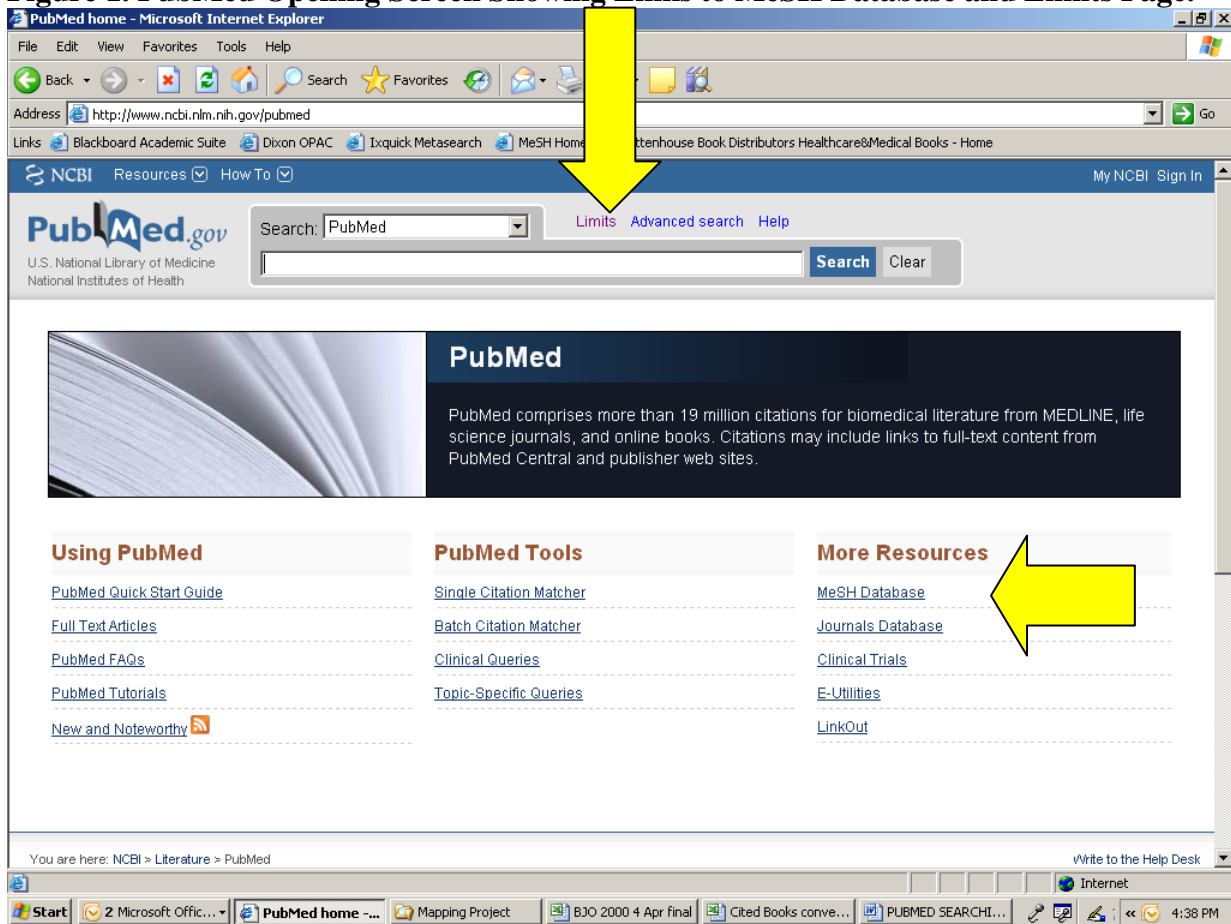


Figure 2. Opening Screen for MeSH.

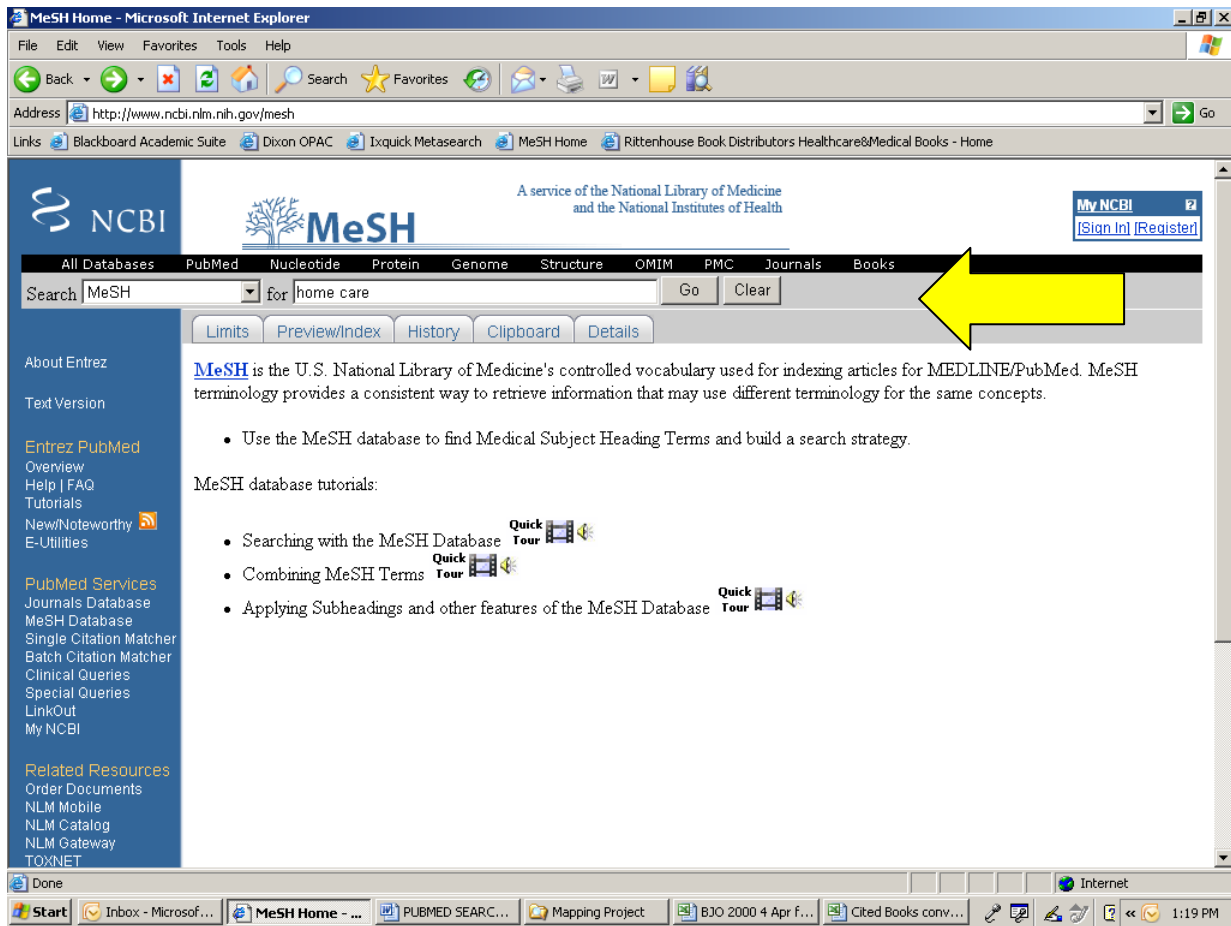


Figure 3. MeSH Tree for Home Care Services.

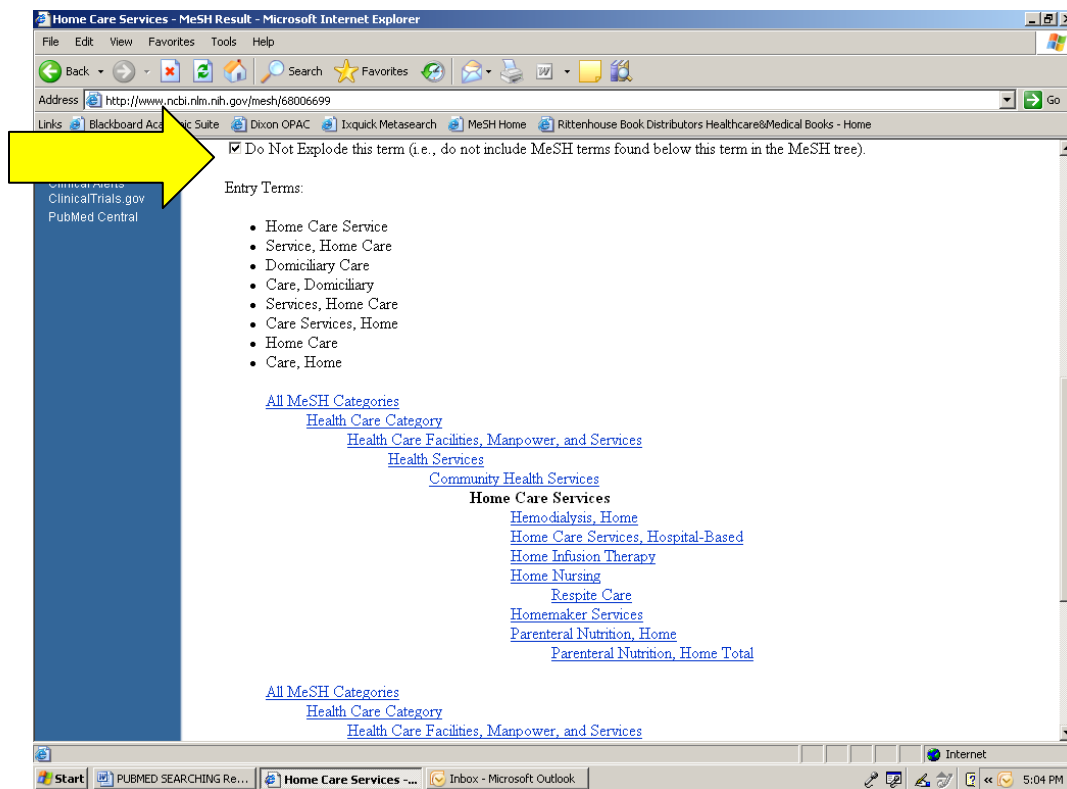


Figure 4. Sending Your Search Term to Search PubMed.

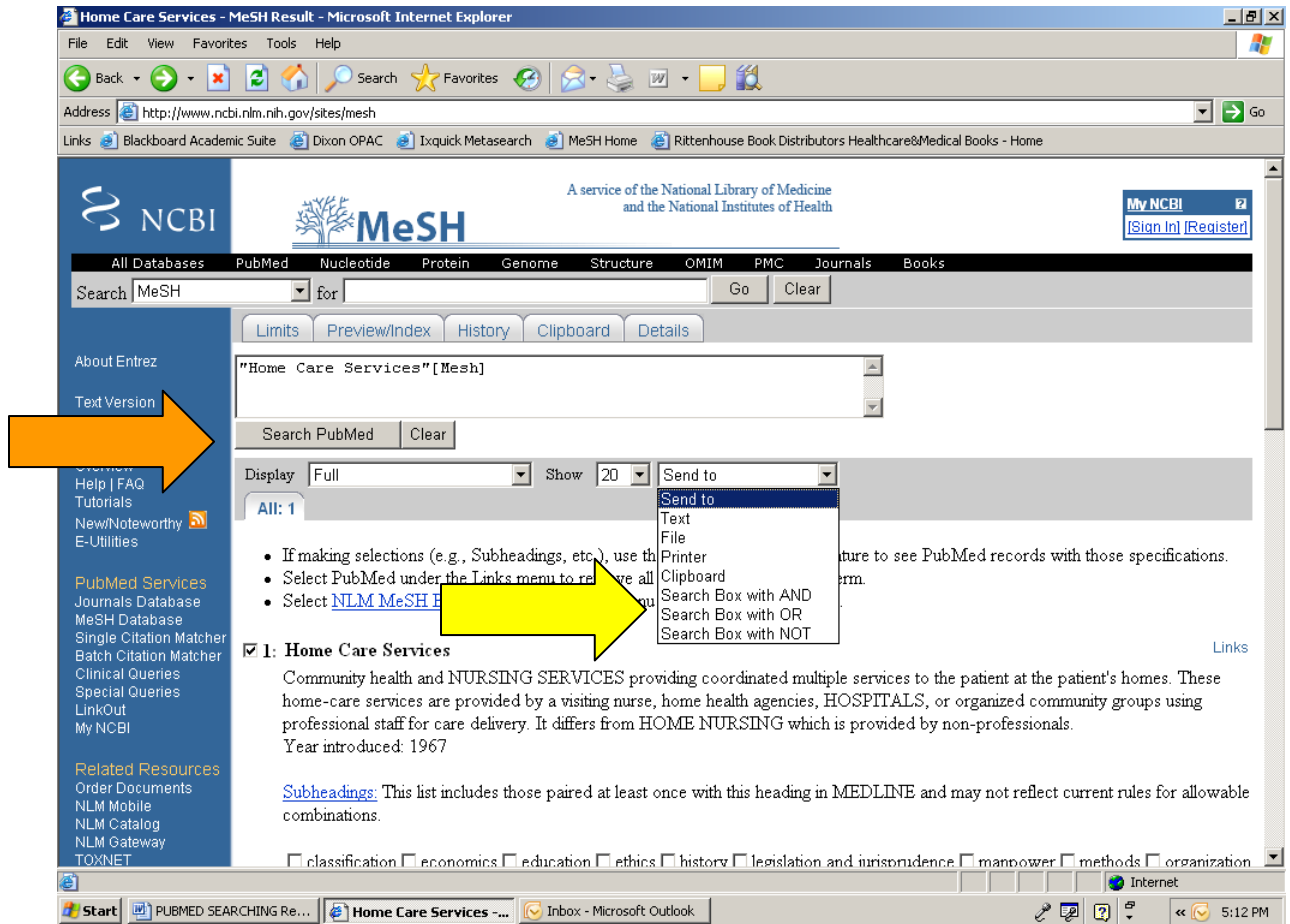


Figure 5. PubMed Limits Screen.

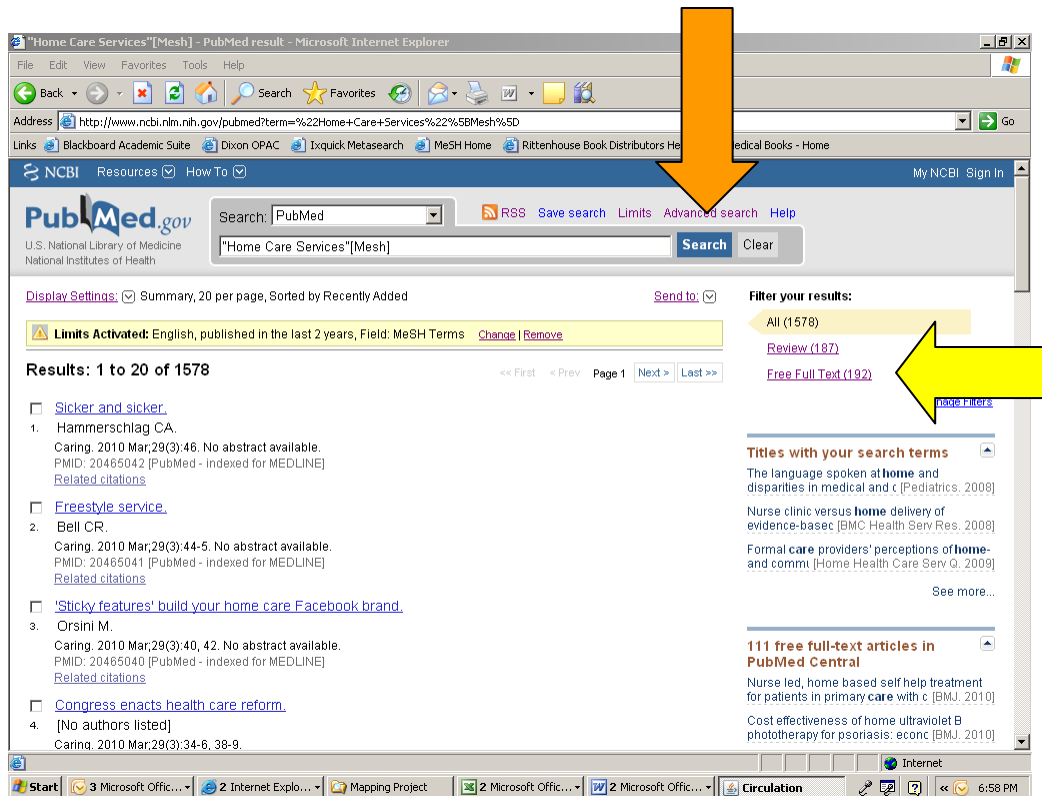


Figure 7. Use of MeSH Subheadings.

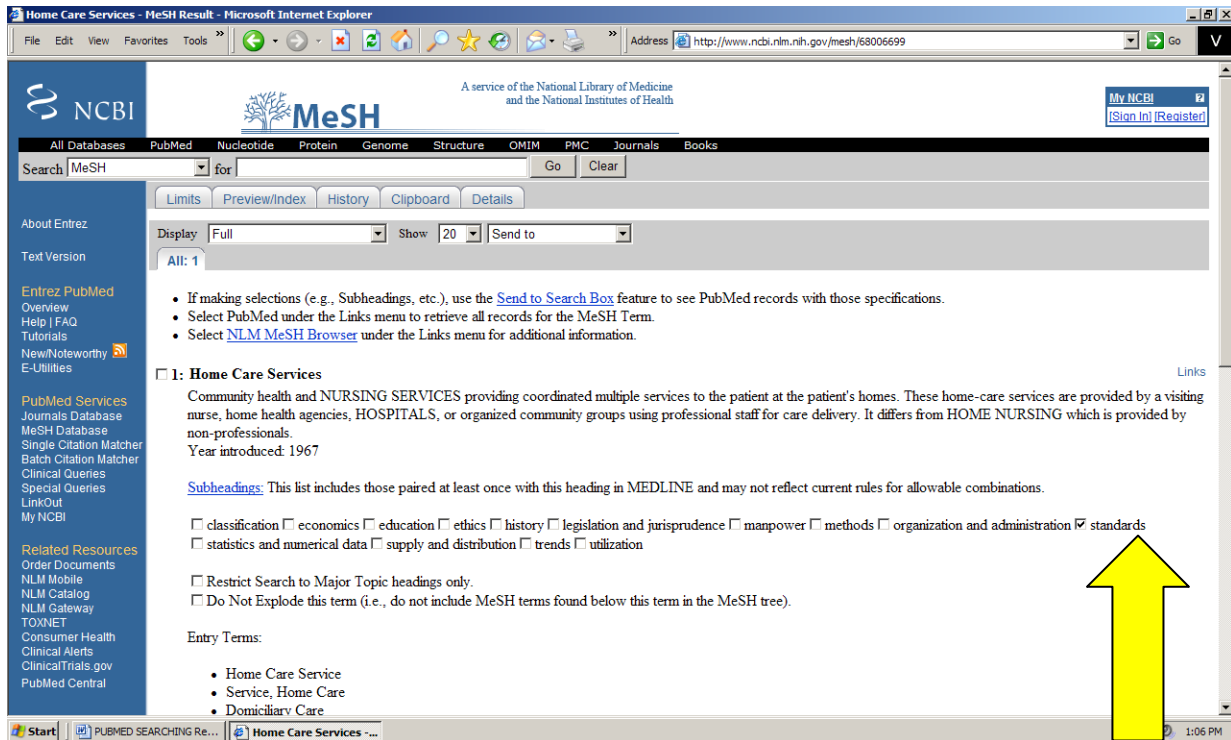


Figure 8. PubMed Advanced Search Screen.

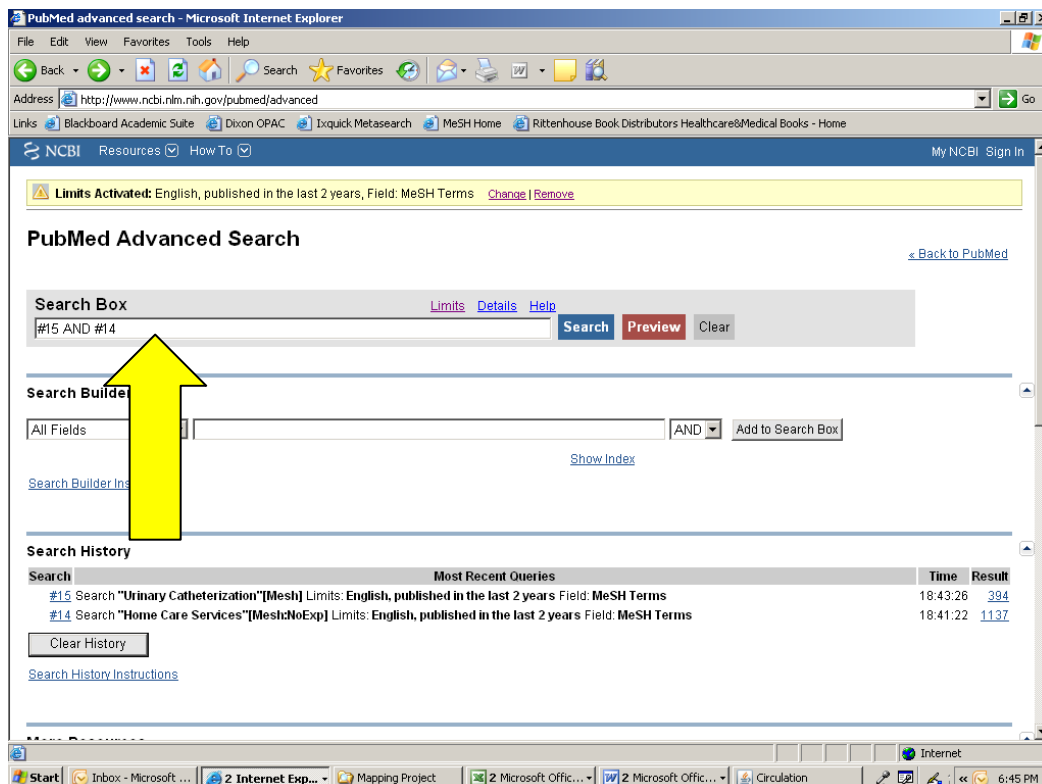


Figure 9. Results of Search Combining *Home Care Services* With *Urinary Catheterization*.
