

Figure S3 (a-f). Comparison of patient baseline samples and donor samples to follow up samples after FMT for each patient by weighted UniFrac distance. The UniFrac distance is a measure of similarity (low distance values) or dissimilarity (high distance values) of the microbial communities when individual samples are compared. Blue bars: UniFrac distance comparing the patient's baseline stool sample to stool samples of the days following FMT. Red bars: UniFrac distance between the donor's stool sample compared to the patient's stool samples after FMT.

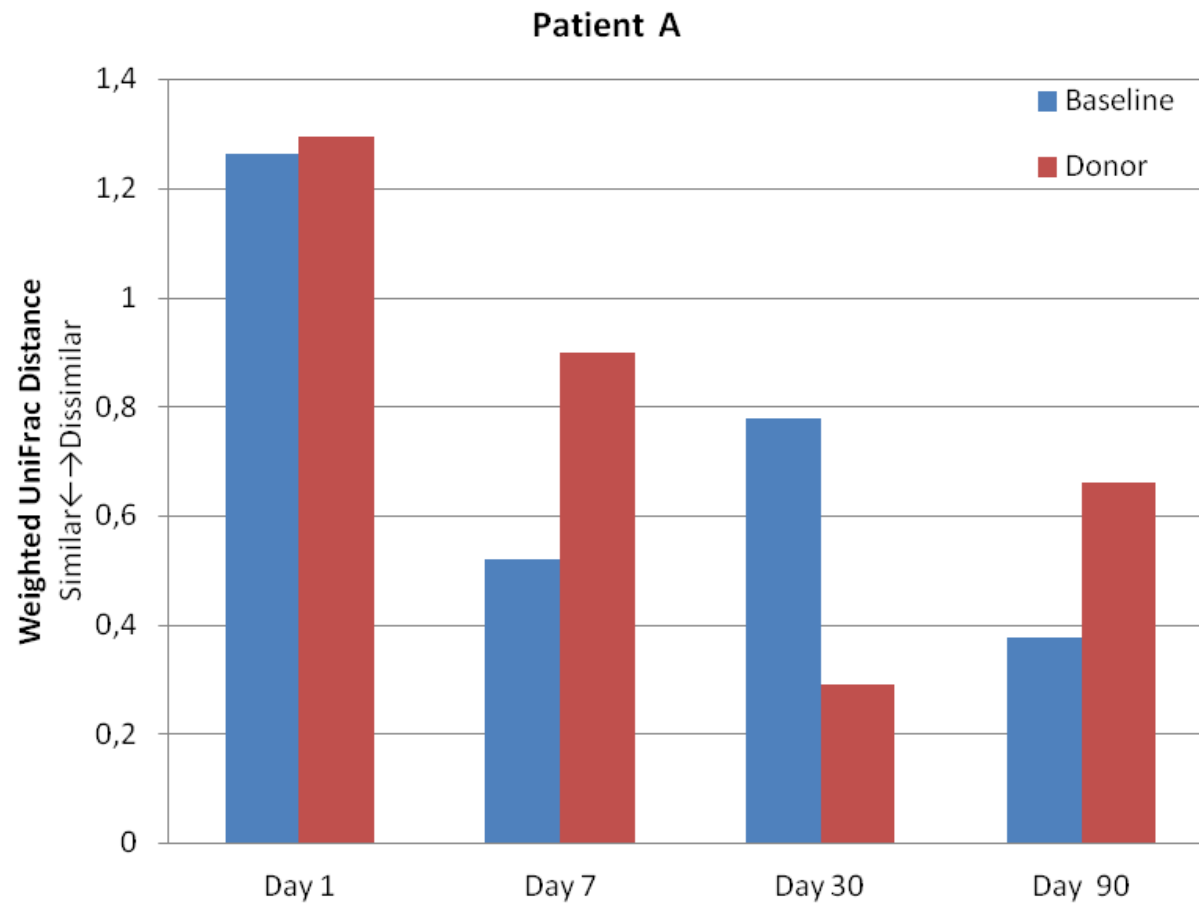

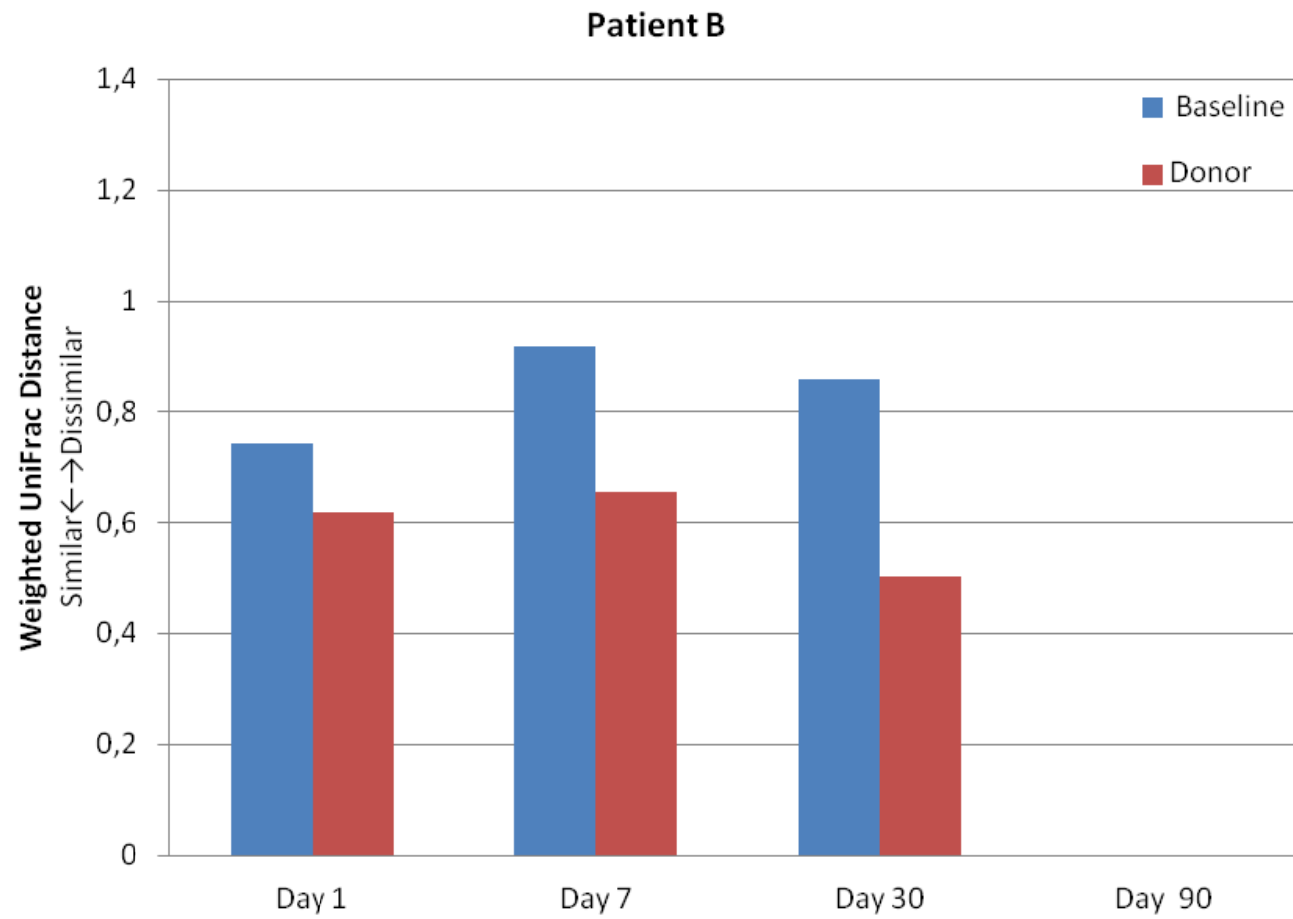

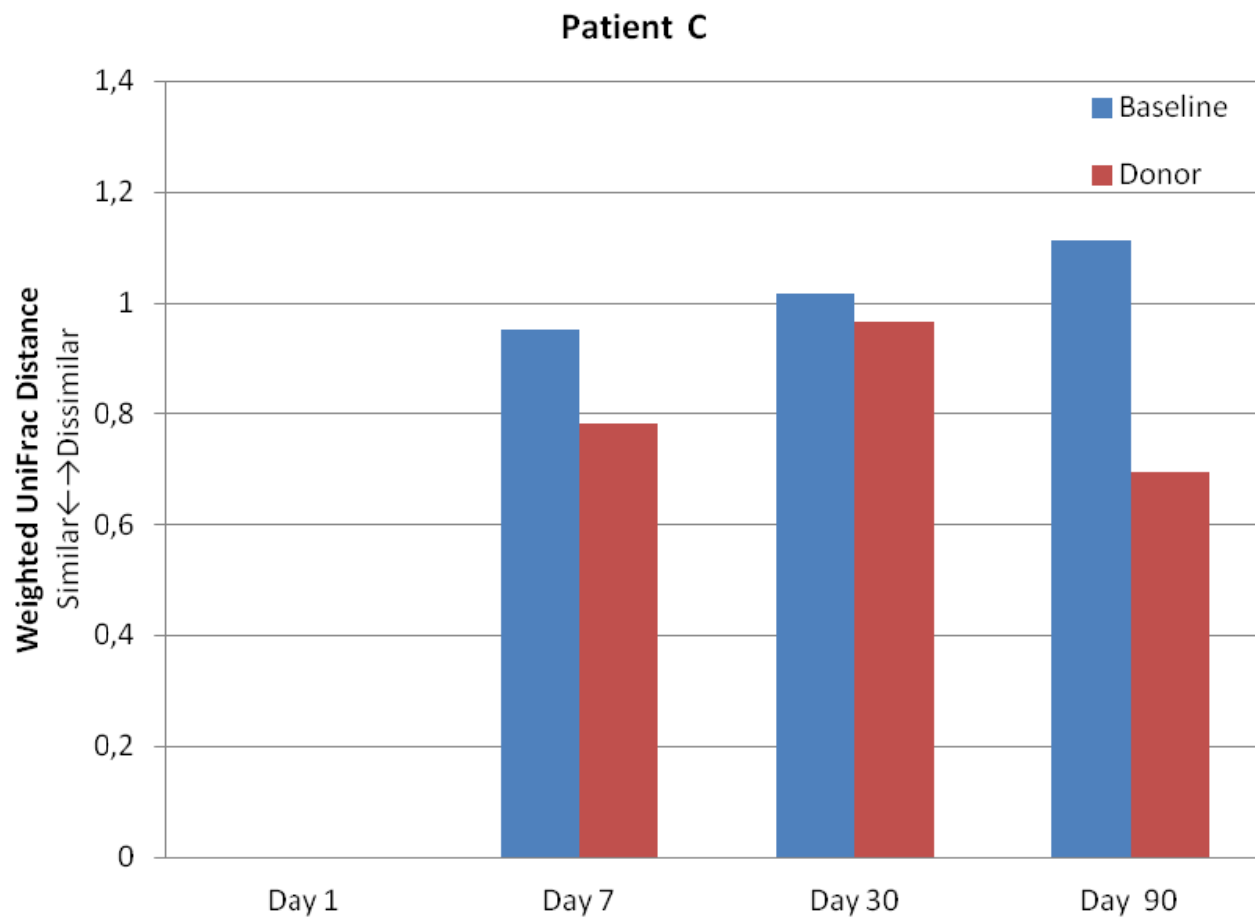

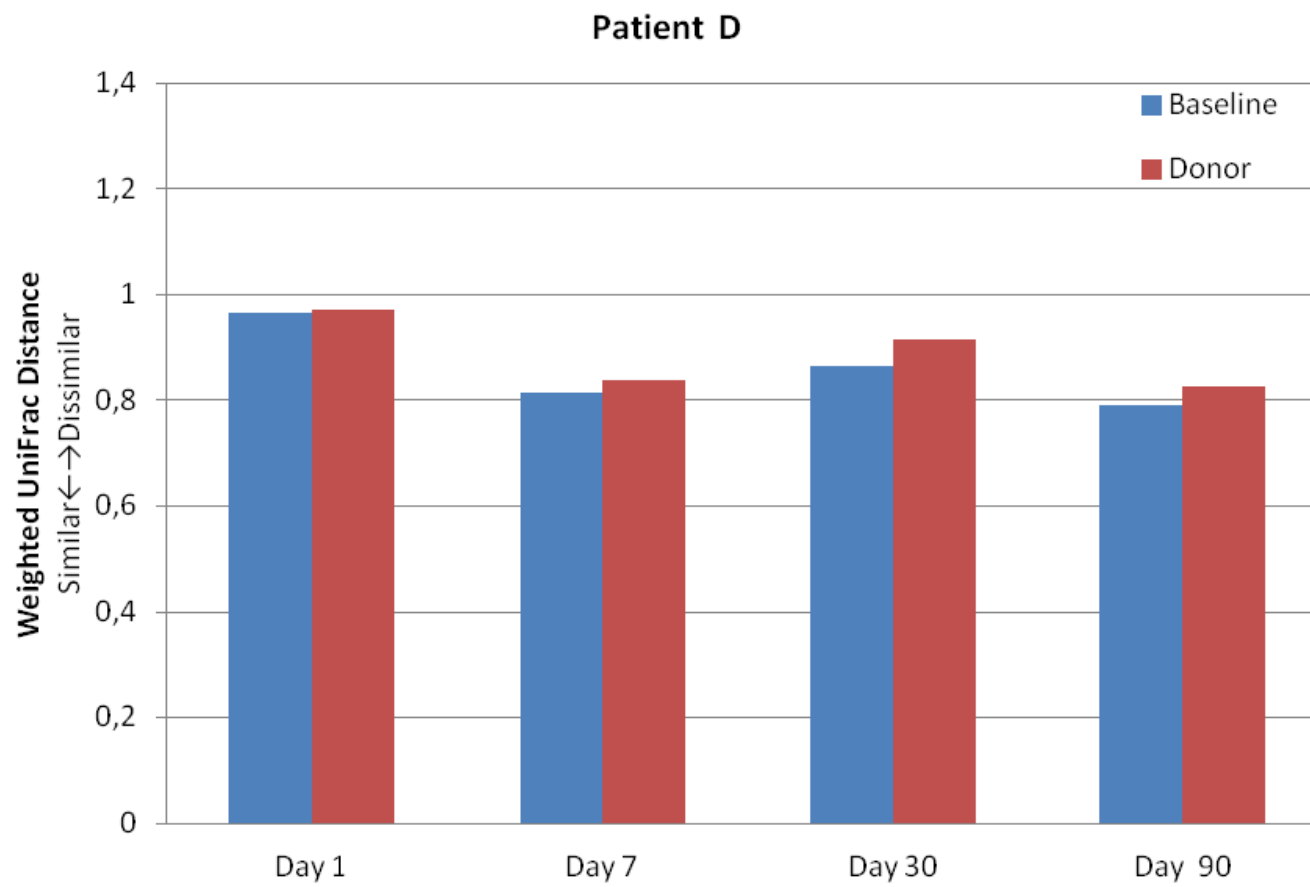

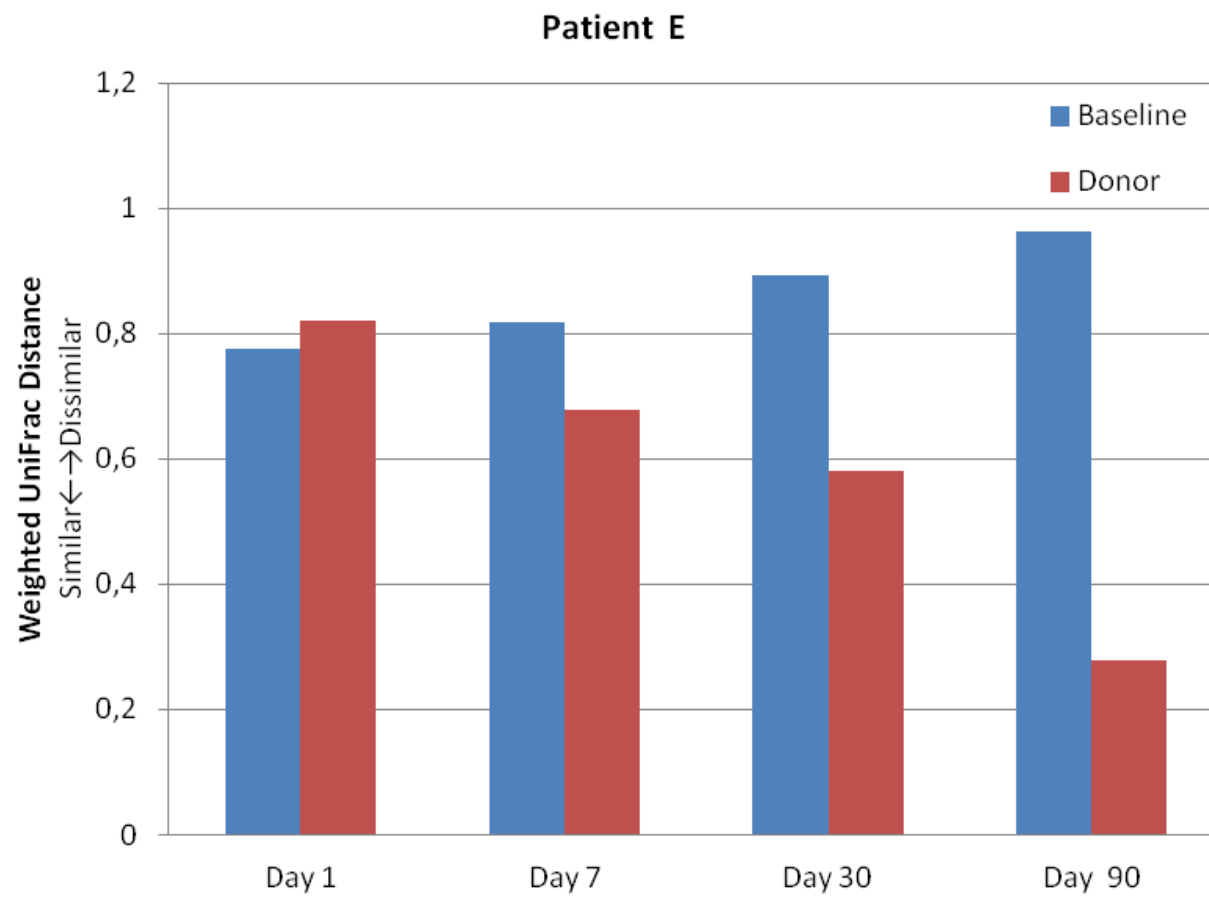
