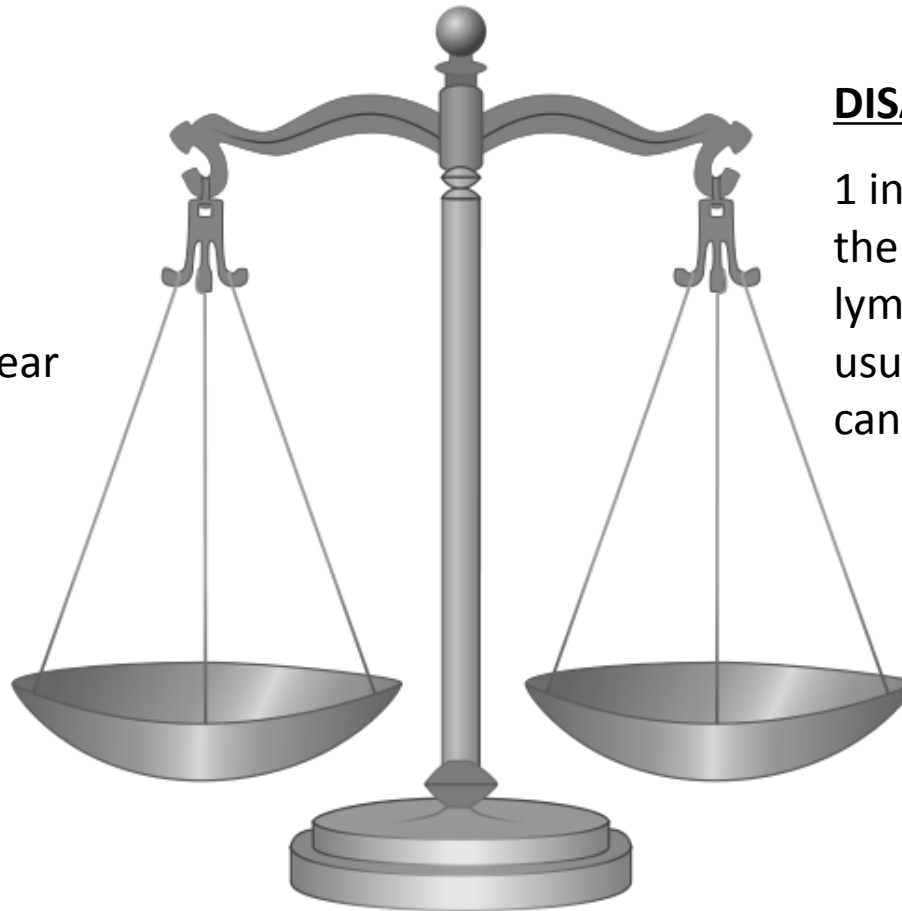


S1: “Scales of justice” for decision-making between sentinel lymph node biopsy and complete inguinal-femoral lymphadenectomy for early vulvar cancer.

ADVANTAGES

Avoids Side Effects of leg swelling which occurs in 60%, with possible pain, infection, and need to wear a stocking



DISADVANTAGES

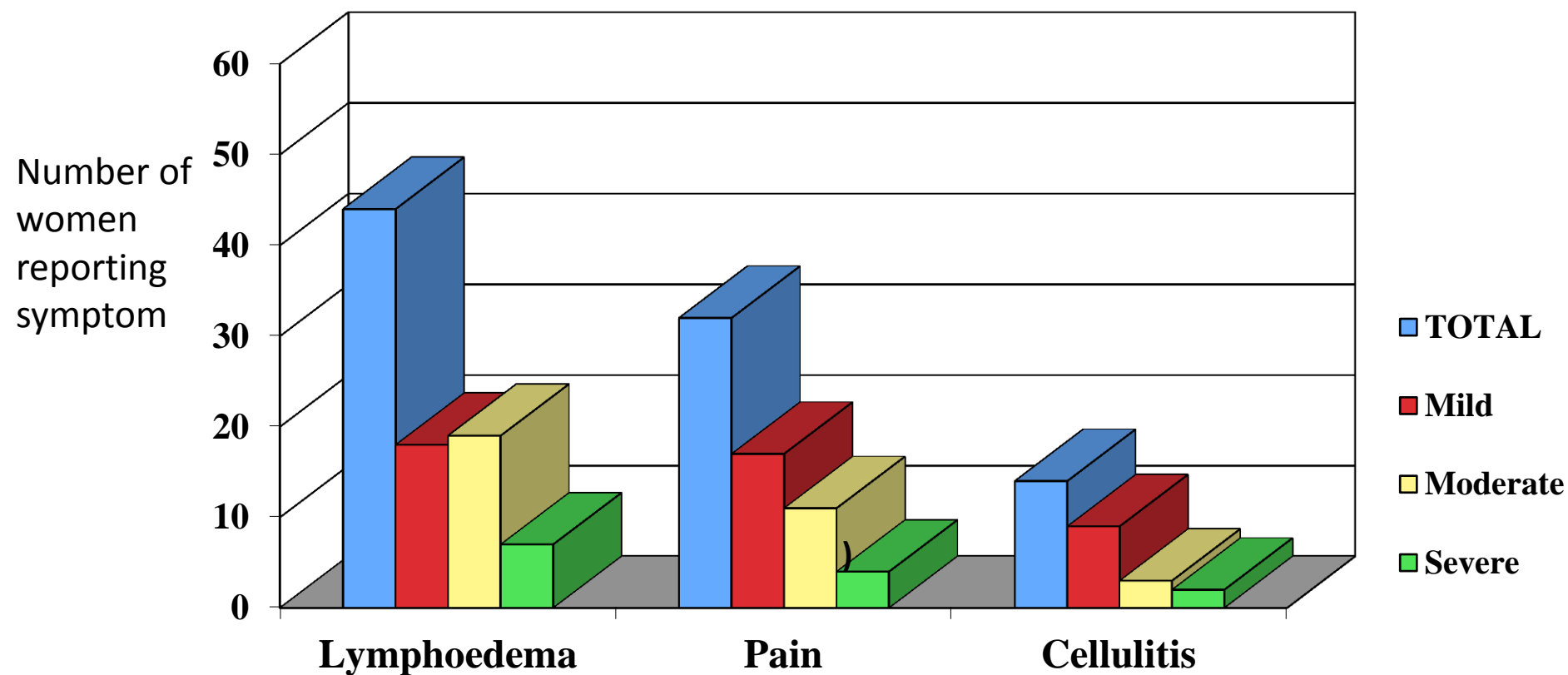
1 in 100 women will have the spread of cancer to the lymph node missed which usually results in death from cancer

S2: The “standard-gamble’ table used to assess what level of risk each woman would take for the sentinel lymph node procedure.

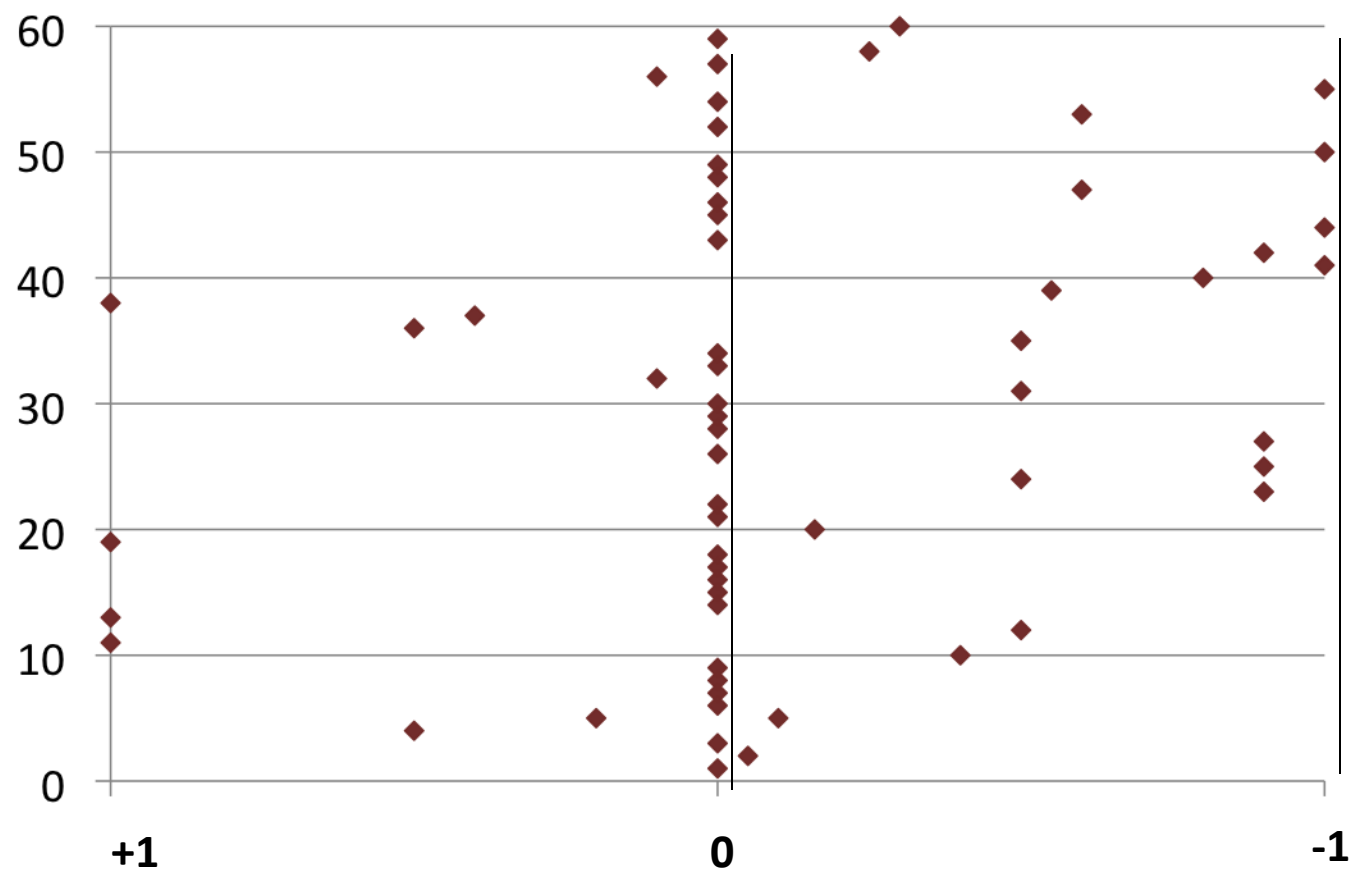
Choose A, B or C for each choice 1, 2, 3 etc....

1	A) 1 in 2 chance of missing cancer spread but no risk of swollen legs, OR B) Always finding the cancer spread but with 60% chance of swollen legs, OR C) Indifferent between A and B
2	A) 1 in 5 chance of missing cancer spread but no risk of swollen legs, OR.....
3	A) 1 in 10
..10	A) 1 in a million chance
