Supplemental material 3 – Different meningococcal vaccines recommended in the 2015 French vaccination schedule

- 1) General recommendation (the whole population):
 - 12 months: 1 dose (meningococcal serogroup C conjugate vaccine)
 - Until 24 years old: 1 catch-up dose (meningococcal serogroup C conjugate vaccine)
- Specific indications for at-risk patients (meningococcal serogroup ACYW135 conjugate vaccine)
 - Complement terminal fraction deficiency
 - Eculizumab treatment
 - Asplenia
 - Haematopoietic stem cell transplant
- 3) Patients who have been vaccinated with a meningococcal serogroup ACYW135 polysaccharide vaccine or with an AC polysaccharide vaccine: must wait three years before being vaccinated with a conjugate vaccine
- 4) Recommendation for contacts around a patient with meningococcal disease
 - Serogroup C disease: meningococcal serogroup C conjugate vaccine
 - Serogroup AYW135: meningococcal serogroup ACYW135 conjugate vaccine
 - Children between 6 and 12 months: meningococcal AC polysaccharide vaccine
