

TABLE E-1 Range of movement of the knee and ankle joint in the subjects treated with reconstruction. A negative value for the knee signifies a lack of extension in comparison with the contralateral, uninjured knee, while for the ankle it signifies an inability to reach the neutral (plantigrade) position. All measurements were performed by the same investigator with the patient lying in the supine position and with the aid of a clinical goniometer.
