





Dorsiflexion range of motion (p = 0.004)





Recurrence seen in 19% (71) of 382 patients who were typically discharged at 5 years of age

Ponseti casting remains effective for recurrent idiopathic clubfoot. But longer follow-up periods may be needed as recurrence can occur as late as 7 years of age.
