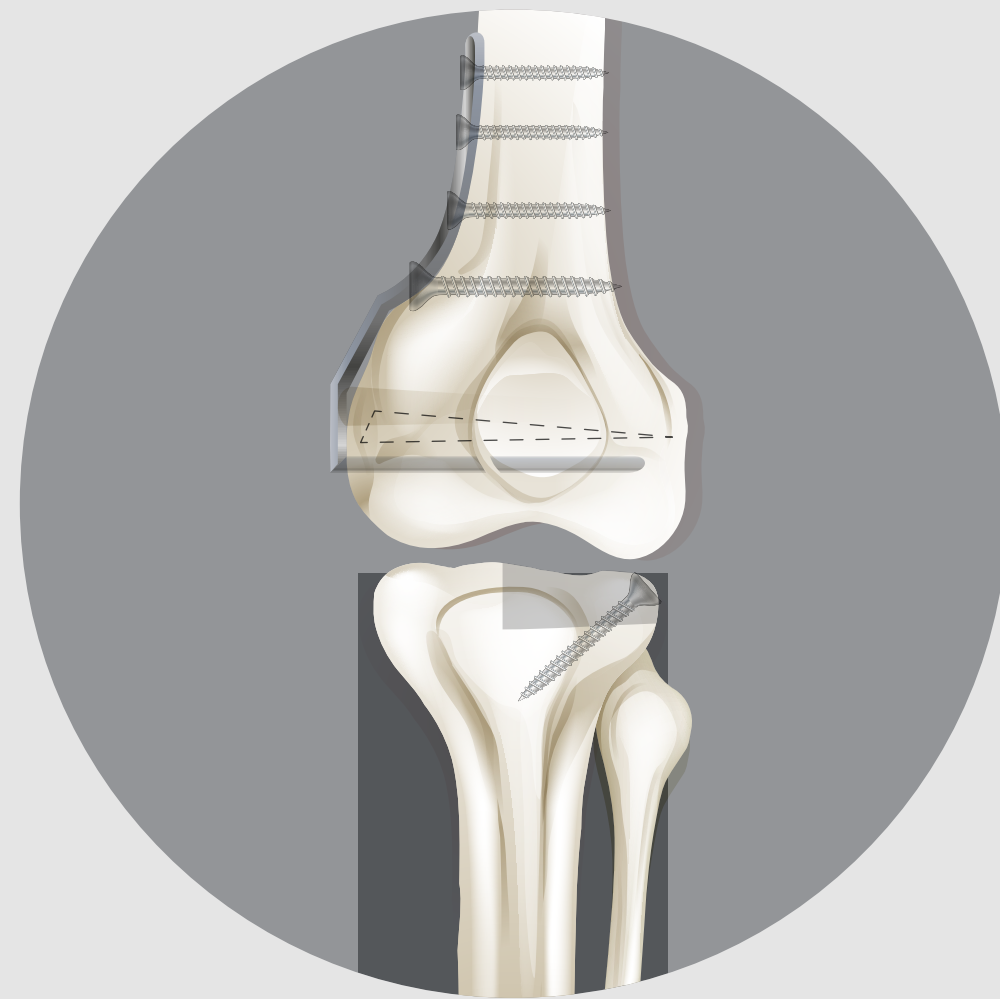


# Fresh Osteochondral Allografts for Posttraumatic Tibial Plateau Lesions

Fresh Osteochondral Allograft (FOCA) is a therapeutic option for large posttraumatic tibial osteochondral defects in young patients



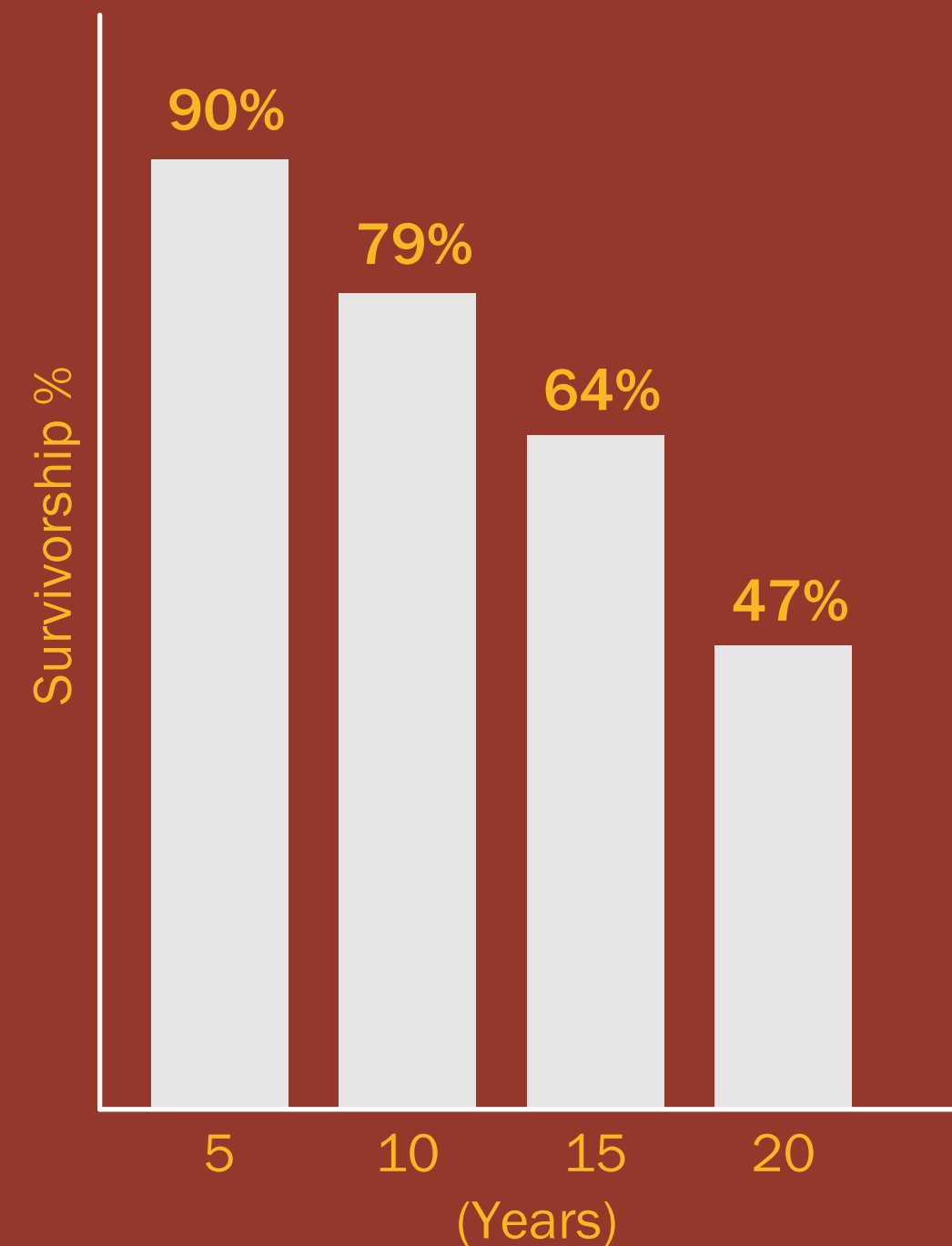
Study evaluated long-term outcomes of FOCA and factors affecting graft survivorship in 113 patients

Primary outcome: Survivorship

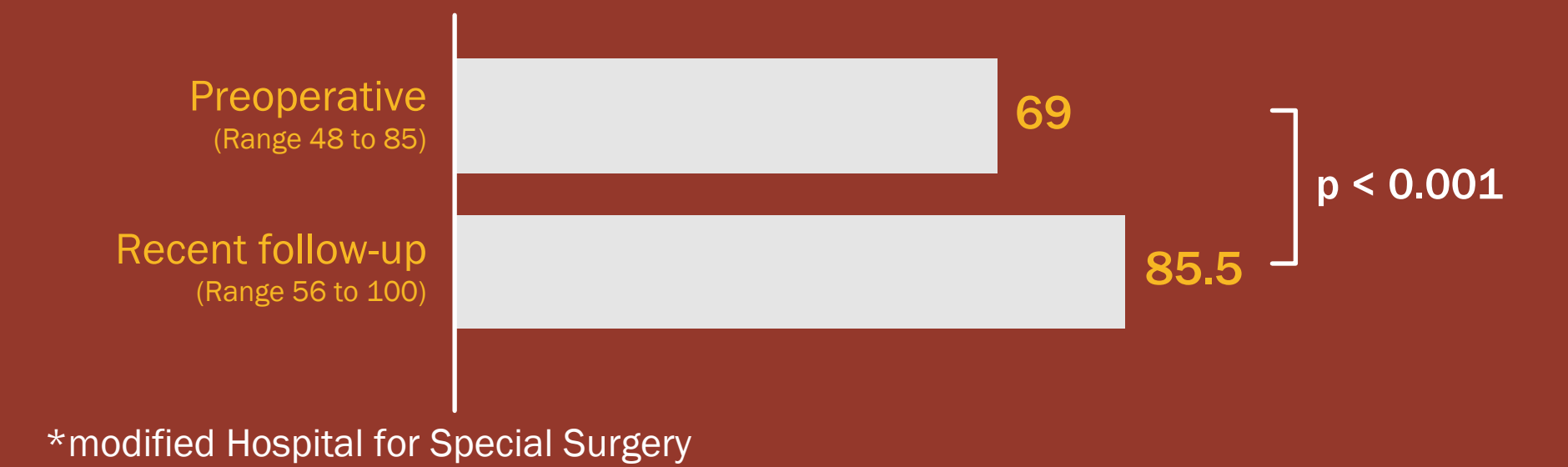
Secondary outcome: Functional Scores



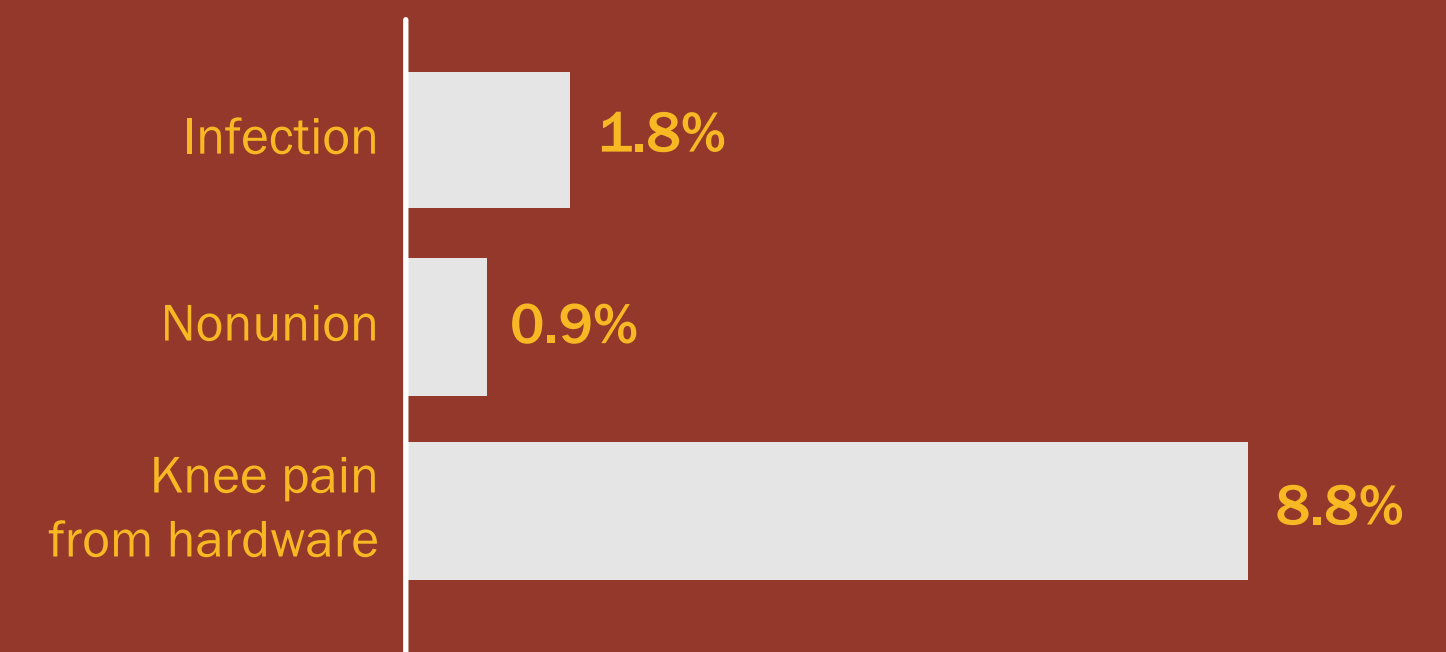
Younger age + fewer prior surgeries were associated with longer survivorship



Functional outcomes: (mHSS score)
