

Table 4. Exclusion and Inclusion Criteria

Exclusion Criteria For EEPM Guideline Order
The patient is excluded from participation in the EEPM Guidelines if any of the following contraindications are present:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unstable Fractures • Unstable Intra-Cranial Pressure • Cerebral Spinal Fluid Leak, or unstable spinal edema • Acute and/or unstable Neurological Brain injury • Severe delirium or dementia • Comfort Care • Previous Level of Function (PLOF) bed bound and or severe pre-existing handicap
Inclusion Criteria For Implementation of Order EEPM Guideline Interventions Past Phase I:
The patient must demonstrate the following prior to implementing EEPM interventions:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No Exclusion Criteria Present • RR < 30 breaths per minutes, if RR > 30 x 5 minutes patient must be excluded • HR < 130 at rest, if HR change of greater than 20 bpm (over 100) in the last hour patient must be excluded • HR > 40 BPM • MAP > 60 mmHg, no orthostasis • Oxygen Saturation > 90% • FiO2 <60% • PEEP <10 cmH2O • Ventilator Synchrony • Hemodynamically stable: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ No dependence on inotropic/vasopressor support (Dependence= high dose, new, and/or increased over last 2 hours) ○ Not receiving fluid boluses or a significant amount of blood products • No active MI in the last 24 hours • No dysrhythmia requiring a new antiarrhythmic agent in the last 24 hours • No active nerve block agents or therapies inhibiting movement or sensation of the extremities • No metabolic Acidosis: Arterial PH>7.25 • Hemoglobin > 8 g/dl • Platelet Count > 20,000 • INR < 3 (if INR>3, do not progress past Phase 3)
