


FIGURE. Managing DMF-Associated GI AEs


Over the past 6 months, have you recommended pharmacologic interventions to manage GI AEs? (n=190; Round 2)




Over the past 6 months, have you recommended nonpharmacologic interventions to manage GI AEs? (n=190; Round 2)




If yes, what percentage of patients using pharmacologic interventions stayed on DMF? (n=143; Round 2)
