Strategies for Virtual Bereavement Care

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ABSTRACT: The contagiousness of some illnesses (e.g., COVID-19) limits the ways in which families can interact with their dying loved ones who have been admitted to the hospital, especially in the intensive care unit. As a result, nurses have developed culturally relevant strategies for virtual bereavement care for patients and families pre-death, peri-death, and post-death. This article provides specific ways nurses can support, communicate, and facilitate meaningful rituals when patients die in isolation.
