Students were placed in new course sections as they returned in future sessions and were able to reuse previously completed course work to complete their course(s). Total numbers of students taking part in the initiative were not shared publicly.

Incomplete Accommodations

Students experiencing hardships who successfully completed at least 75% of the course requirements were granted up to 6 weeks following the close of the session to complete coursework.

Option extended from 6 to 8 weeks with 75% successful course completion requirement removed.
