Living donation rates declined over 20 years

3% annual decline for non-Hispanic white, black, and Hispanic children, but remained stable for Asian children

Racial disparities persisted over time



Non-Hispanic white children had more access to living donors



Most donors were parents

Over 60% of living donations were from parent to child



Black and Hispanic white children had higher degree of sibling donors
