Is prosocial behaviour associated with increased registration for deceased organ donation? A cross-sectional study of Ontario, Canada

The characteristics of the community in which one lives may promote organ donor registration



Objective: To assess if the likelihood that an individual is a registered deceased organ donor in Ontario, Canada is associated with charitable giving, an indicator of community-level prosocial behaviour



29.52% of Ontarians were registered as organ donors as of March 31, 2016



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Organ donor registration rates differ across communities

Community-level charitable giving is related to organ donor registration.
This relationship can be explained by community-level factors such as residential mobility, poverty, and ethnic/immigrant concentration



Identifying the characteristics of populations and communities with low organ donor registration rates may inform future initiatives in the area of organ donation awareness and promotion
