
Late-onset Epilepsy and Mortality: Is There a Relation?



Data from Centers for Medicare Services fee-for-service claims



9,090 participants aged 45–64 years



678 participants who developed LOE



Median follow-up 11.5 years




Identification of Mortality hazard associated with LOE (adjusted hazard ratio, AHR)

Cause of death



Patients with LOE had increased hazard of mortality (AHR = 2.39, 95% CI: 2.21-2.71)

Mortality in patients with LOE was mostly due to



Likely causes of epilepsy







Other neurologic conditions

End-stage renal disease

People with late-onset epilepsy are at increased risk of death, mainly due to stroke and dementia
