Step 1: analysis of reported difficulties
<p>Spontaneously reported difficulties</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Linking every spontaneously reported complaint to one or more ICF codes • Calculating per ICF code how many patients report at least one problem in this category <p>Standardized questionnaires</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Linking every item to one or more ICF codes • Converting scaled scores into dichotomous scores (absence or presence of the problem the item refers to) • Calculating per ICF code how many patients report presence of a problem on at least one of the items in this category
Step 2: in-depth analysis
<p>Standardized questionnaires</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Examining on the item level the percentages of patients reporting the presence of a problem. This was done for problems that appeared less directly related to missing half of the visual field.
