Hemodynamic instability in an 85-year-old patient after removal of an intra-aortic balloon pump 2 days after cardiac surgery associated with normal cerebral oximetry values but elevated lactate. (A,B) Upon examination of the liver using transesophageal echocardiography, air was present in the portal vein (arrow).
