

Supplementary Table 3. The preset doses of two anticoagulation regimens*.

Enoxaparin	1mg/kg bid or 1.5mg/kg qd or 1mg/kg qd or 0.5 mg/kg bid or 40 mg bid or > 40 mg qd	≤ 40 mg qd or < 1mg/kg qd
Dalteparin	≥ 5000 IU qd	2500-5000 IU qd
Tinzaparin	≥ 4500 IU qd	2500-4500 IU qd
Fondaparinux	≥ 5 mg qd	2.5 mg qd
Heparin	7500 IU tid	5000 IU tid
Rivaroxaban	15 mg qd	10 mg qd
Apixaban	≥ 5 mg bid	2.5 mg bid
Bemiparin	5000 IU qd or 115 IU/kg qd	3500 IU qd

I-TA = intermediate-to-therapeutic anticoagulation; PA = prophylactic anticoagulation; qd = once a day; bid = twice a day; tid = three times a day; IU = international unit.

*If necessary, the dose can be adjusted according to creatinine clearance, body mass index or other factors.
