Repeated measures linear mixed model estimation of the difference in (A) Mini-Mental State Examination (MMSE) scores and (B) standardized z-scores of activities of daily living (ADL) between the lowest and highest quartile (Q) versus the middle fifty percent group of systolic blood pressure with every six months since baseline. Models were corrected for sex (all) and age (only the Māori and TOOTH cohort). The estimates of the individual cohorts were pooled using a random-effects models with inverse-variance weighting. SE: standard error. IV: inverse variance. CI: confidence interval.
