1A: Day 13 of illness revealed active vitritis, optic nerve swelling, arteriolar sheathing and extensive circumferential peripheral necrotic retinitis in the left eye with a normal right eye. 1B: Day 21 of illness showed early features of focal retinitis and vasculitis (white arrow) in the previously healthy right eye. The left eye necrosis resolved but still showed significant inflammation and vitritis
