

## Supplemental Digital Content File 2 (Figure) - Population characteristics by level of

 rurality, all characteristics. Population is total population (millions of people); Pop Density is population density (people per $\mathrm{km}^{2}$ ); Pop Change is change in total population from 2010 to 2018 (\%); White, Black, AIAN (American Indian and Alaska Native), Asian, and Hispanic are percent of the population (\%); BA Degree is the age $\pm 25$ population with a bachelor's degree (\%); $<200 \%$ poverty is the population living in households with incomes less than $200 \%$ of the federal poverty level; Health Ins is the percentage of population age $<65$ with health insurance; Hospital and Primary Care are people with 30 minute travel time access to an acute care hospital (\%); Hosp, 100 Beds is access to a hospital with at least 100 beds (\%); Hosp, OR is access to a hospital with an operating room (\%); Primary Care and Dentists are access to a primary care physician and dentist respectively (\%); and Asthma, Diabetes, Heart Disease, and Depression are prevalence in the age $\pm 18$ population (\%).
