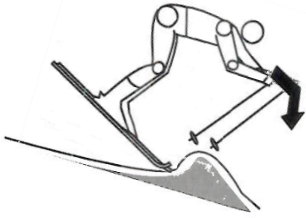

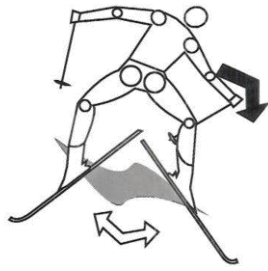

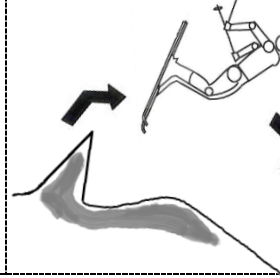

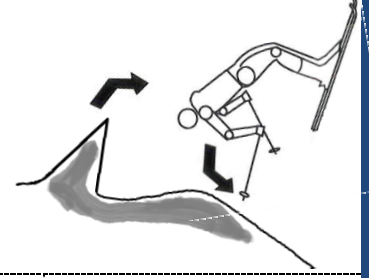


Falling while jumping

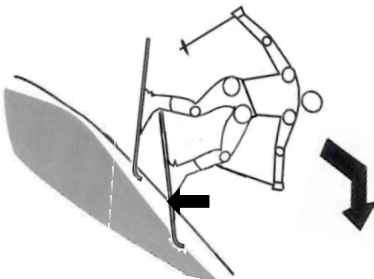

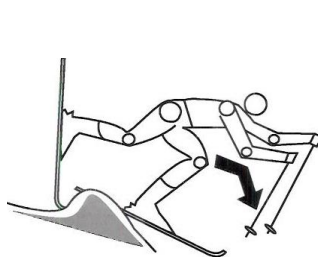


Falling sideways

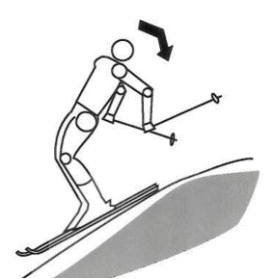

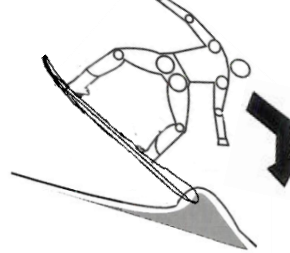

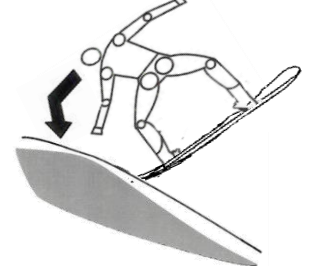

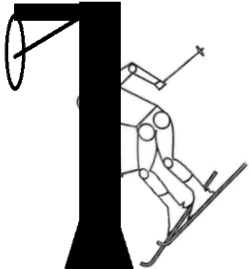

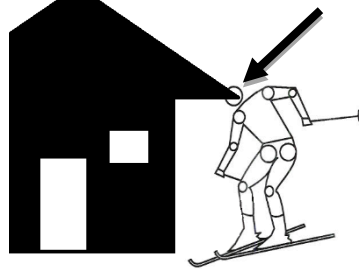


Collision with a stationary object (tree, rock, pylon ...)

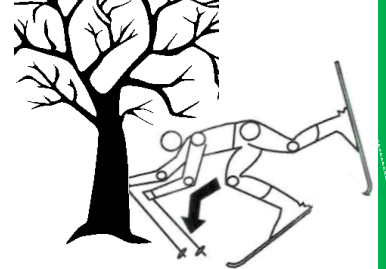

Branch, platter of the ski lift...

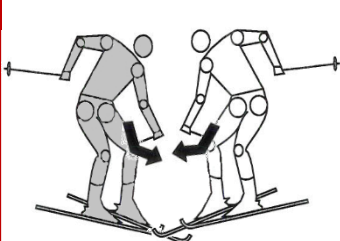


☐ self fall followed by the collision with the object

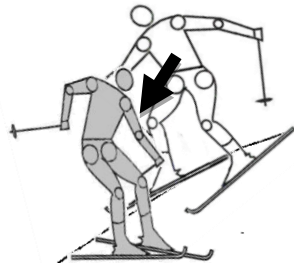


Collision with another person
