 3. Every patient will have appropriate surgical star marking (when indicated) that is clear to patients, families and all insurances of the Persoperative Team and all insurances of the Persoperative Team will be patients.

 4. The Persoperative Team will confirm the plan with patient and family members present prior to surgery and encourage families is speak up.

 5. All team members including patients and families will stop, engage and participate in time outs.
